

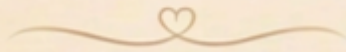

But... why do so many women struggle to believe this?



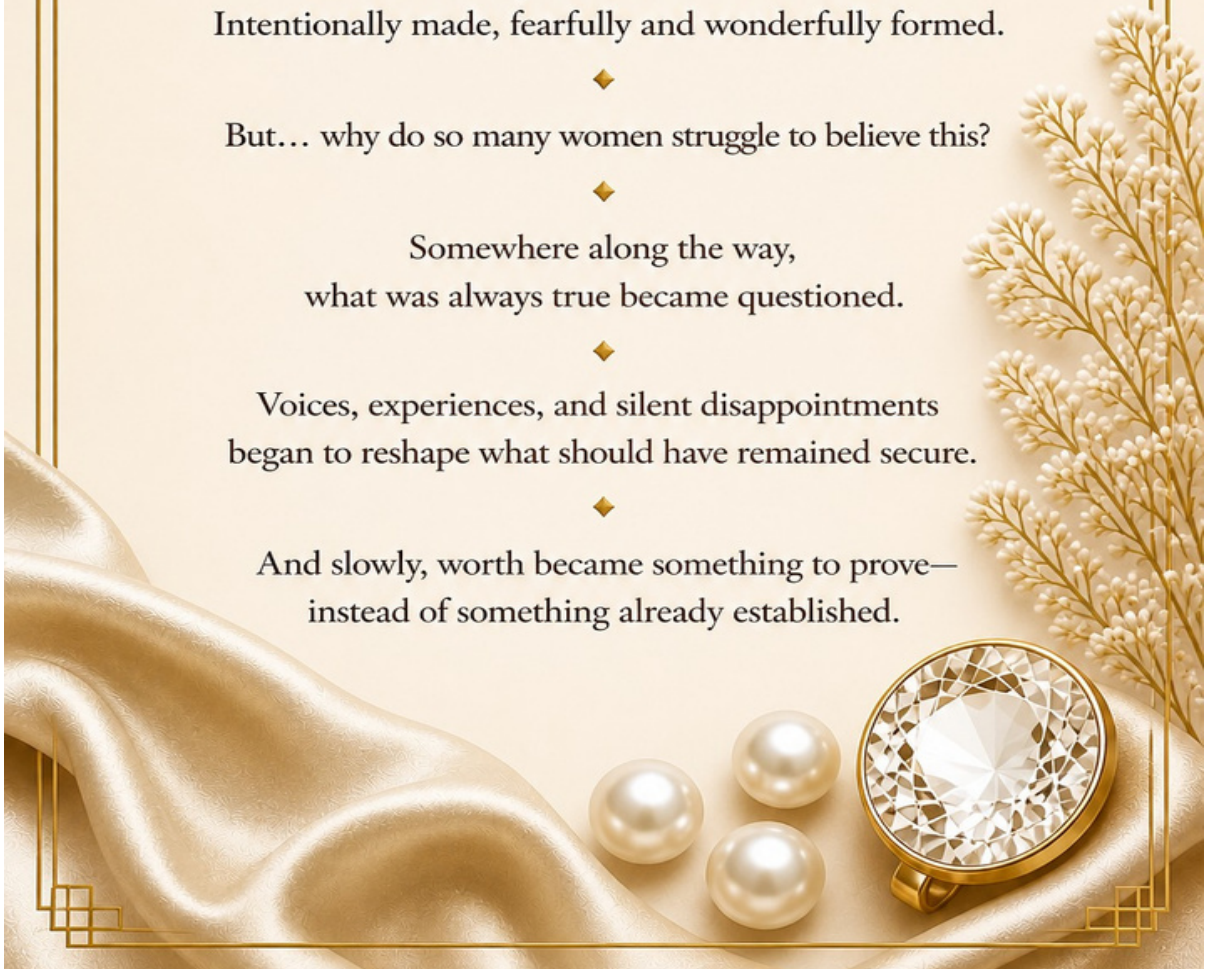
Somewhere along the way,

Silence will make you doubt yourself.



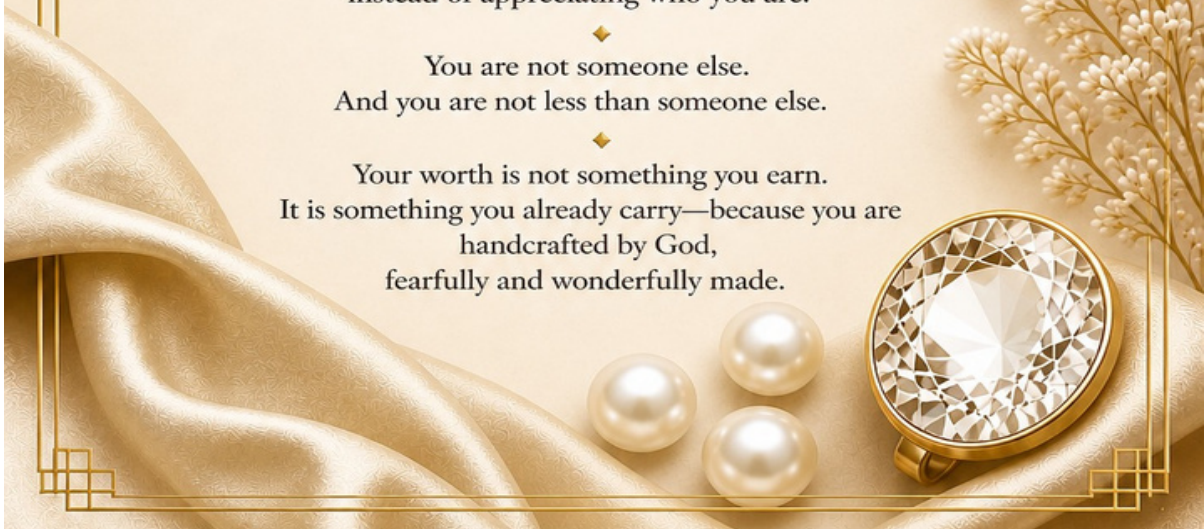
And before you realize it,

You don't have to earn it.

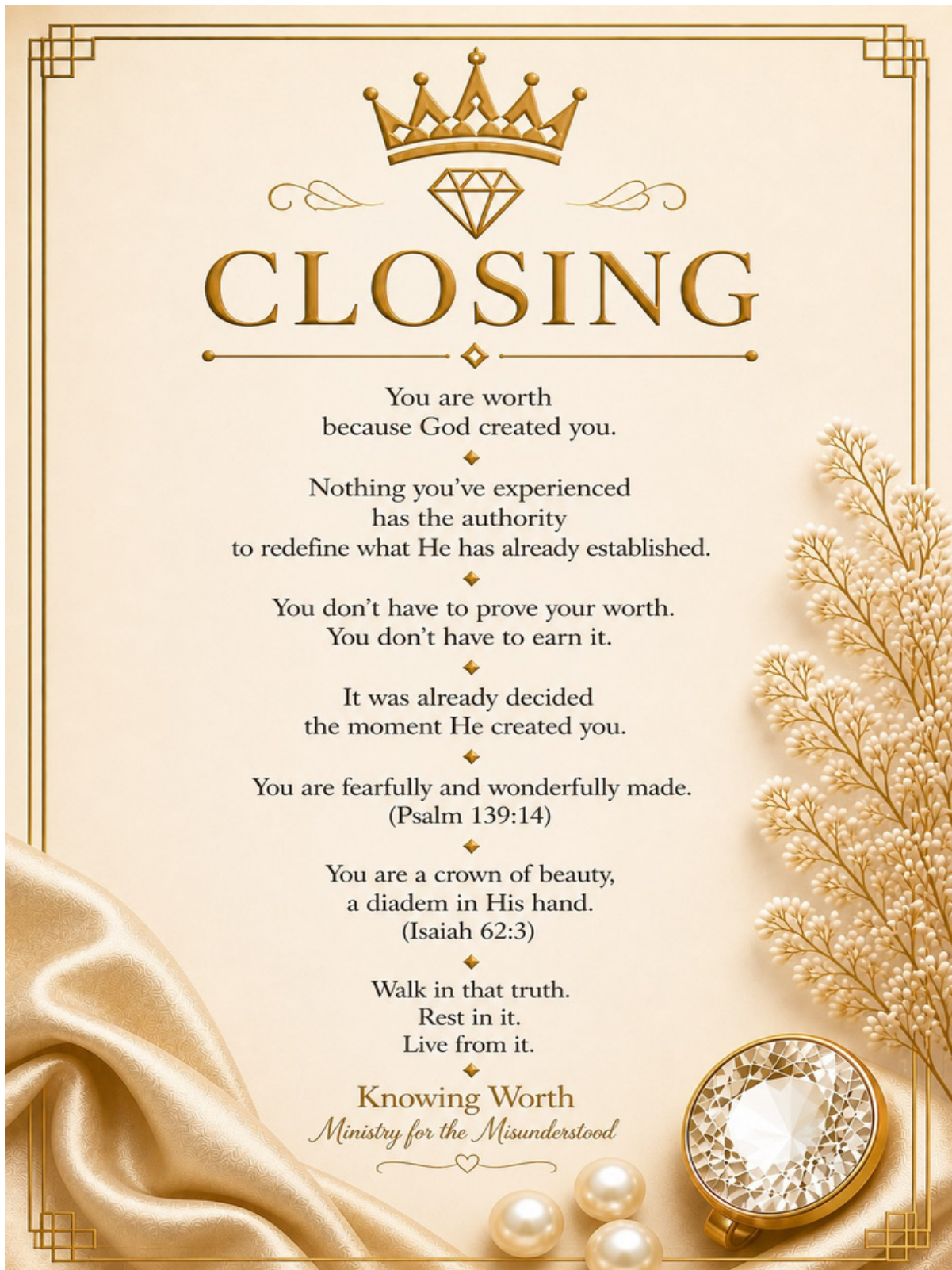
It was already decided
